- Based and operate within North Lanarkshire
- Annual income £75,000 or less
- Bank account registered in the name of your group or organisation
- Have a governing document (ie a Constitution or Term or Reference)
- Open to joining our network and can commit to attending 2 meetings within 12 months
- If you have been a previous grantee; has your reporting been signed off? Has it been more than 12 months since your last award?

What are we unable to fund?

These are some of the things that we are unable to fund. Our goal is to grow Engagement and Participation for underrepresented groups throughout North Lanarkshire so anything we fund must be related directly to E&P activities

- Rent of office space, general administrations and any remedial or repair works
- Salaries for permanent staff or any personal costs
- Purchase of equipment (Laptops, Phones etc)
- Any day trips or outings within the UK or abroad

- Any political work
- Medication
